Notification and Inspeximus by the Consistory Court of York of the indulgence granted by Boniface IX (Pope 1389 – 1404) for those rebuilding the stone bridge over the Tweed. On vellum, 28 lines, vellum tag for seal. Granted to Sir Henry de Percy alias Hotspur (1364 – 1403) who was keeper of the town and castle of Berwick and played a prominent part in border politics. In 1401 he was granted £500 from various port customs for the making of the new bridge under the supervision of the Earls of Northumberland and Westmoreland.

Dated at Rome, 8 May 1400, the notification dated at York 10 June 1402. (note the Sotherby's auction lot description states that the date at Rome is 8 May 1391. This appears to be an error).
